Directions: To Shotgun Sports Area for trap/skeet/5stand/springing teal and the Shotgun Building, from Hwy 30 in Waterman, drive south on Elm St. about 1 mile. Turn west onto Rueff Rd and drive about ½ mile, then turn north into the Shotgun Sports gate. (Go to the Shotgun Sports building to obtain game cards for all our clays games including for the Sporting Clays Course.) To the Sporting Clays area from Hwy 30 in Waterman, go south on Elm St. about 1 mile. Turn west on Rueff Rd. Drive about 1 mile and turn south into the Sporting Clays gate.
